

Pre-surgical Instructions

All spay/neuter and/or any pets going in for surgery:

<u>Cats:</u> Please make sure to bring them in a **SECURE** cat carrier. Feral cats must be in traps. We will not accept cats if they are not in a proper carrier. If you have more than one cat, they all must be in their own carrier. No food 8 hours before your appointment time, but water is ok.

<u>Dogs:</u> Please make sure to have them on leash. No food 8 hours before your appointment time. Water is ok.

<u>Rabbits/Rats/Guinea Pigs:</u> Please make sure to bring them in a **SECURE** carrier. If you have more than one, please bring them in a separate carrier. Please make sure you bring hay/food in the carrier. Do not take away food or water at any period.

Dentals: No food 8 hours before your appointment time, but water is ok. Same instructions for spay/neuter as above for dogs and cats. Same instructions for dog/cat, spay/neuter.

<u>Check-In:</u> Please come into the office, sign-in, and fill out the necessary forms.

- Pick up is typically between 1-2 pm but could be longer depending on how many surgeries we have that day. You will receive a text as soon as your pet is ready for pick up.
- Please bring any vaccine records. If your pet is not up to date or has no vaccines, we will complete the required vaccines the day of your appointment.
- Please text or email us 24 hours prior if you need to reschedule or cancel this
 appointment. If you cannot make it we would like to fill your spot. We have a long waitlist.

Any other services:

 Please be aware you will have to wait with your pet while your pet is getting their service done. You will not drop off your pet unless they are getting a surgery done.
